**Review** your class schedule (the RED scarf is required to identify persons authorized to attend) ALL GUIDES ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE A KEY GUIDE TOUR--afterwards you should finalize your plan for guiding your class to the two timed events and to as many Static presentations as possible. NOTE: the timing is TIGHT-please "watch the watch". **New item--STATIC CHECK LIST--**we need guides to be sure their classes see as much variety in presentations as possible, ie NOT just animals--and, this will help us plan future events. Turn the sheet in at lunch with your evaluation. Thanks! Check in at the BUS CHECK IN TABLE 10 minutes BEFORE your class arrival-they sometimes arrive early (or late) and you must be available! STAY IN THE AREA and LISTEN CAREFULLY for your class & name to be called; let dispatcher know you have heard them and are meeting the class. Greeting/Welcome: Meet the arriving class, then move them aside to a less congested area, welcome them & introduce yourself. Tell them to ALWAYS follow behind you. Hold your clipboard in the air as you walk so they can see it. Teacher should have a head count & assign chaperones to kids. If necessary, ask the teacher who will translate. Establish a routine and advise each presenter of your language needs. For safety, students must stay with group at all times. The TEACHER IS NOT TO LEAVE THE CLASS. Students should not climb on equipment or pet animals unless the presenter authorizes it. CELL PHONES TURNED OFF (vibrate only)-PLEASE DO NOT TALK ON CELL PHONES! Restroom: Discuss this with teachers/chaperones privately (or else all students will suddenly "have to go") If a student has to go to the restroom a chaperone MUST

Color Area: Do not walk through other color areas. Know the designated entrance/exit for your Color area. Arrive ON TIME-- Check in with your Color Coordinator and follow their instructions. DO NOT leave your color area until all presentations are completed.

Animal Presentation: Each class is scheduled for one animal presentation. Know the location & time as indicated on your class sheet. DO NOT confuse the "Scheduled Animal Presentations" (these marked with signs) with the regular "Static" animals that may be in the same area.
